**GLOBAL POINTS OF PROGRESS - World: conservation efforts have saved up to 48 bird and mammal species from extinction since a 1993 global agreement to protect biodiversity.** Scientists at Newcastle University and BirdLife International analyzed a list of 17,046 species to identify which birds and mammals would likely have gone extinct without intervention. They concluded that extinction rates would have been three to four times higher, likely claiming the California condor, Iberian lynx, pygmy hog, and Puerto Rican Amazon parrot.
