**GLOBAL POINTS OF PROGRESS - United States: Violent crime declined in the United States for the third consecutive year** according to new estimates from the FBI. The rate of violent crime - including murder, rape, robbery and aggravated assault - dropped 1% in 2019, with an average of 367 cases per 100,000 residents. This is the second lowest level since violent crime rates peaked in 1991 at 758 per 100,000.
