**GLOBAL POINTS OF PROGRESS DURING 2020 - Middle East: Legal reforms in the Middle East pushed countries closer to gender equality.** In Afghanistan, mothers' names will now be printed along with fathers' on national identification cards, helping to normalize women's presence in public life. At the same time, a growing #Me Too movement in Egypt has created online spaces for women to speak up about assault, and parliament recently approved a law granting automatic anonymity to sexual violence survivors. Gender roles continue to expand in Saudi Arabia, as well. Men, women, and children can now dine in the same section of a restaurant.

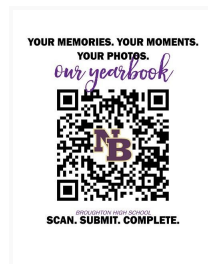
