**GLOBAL POINTS OF PROGRESS - World:** The highest governing soccer organization is introducing a new policy to safeguard the rights of female players, namely mandatory maternity leave. In DEcember, the FIFA Council approved a measure that guarantees female players 14 weeks maternity leave, provides "adequate medical and physical support," and secures their place on the team post-leave. Many players in Europe are already protected under their specific country's labor laws, but FIFA hopes to establish "new global minimum standards" for clubs around the world. Under the new rules, clubs are obligated to reintegrate female players when they return.

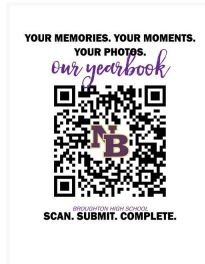
