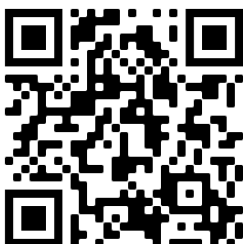

**GLOBAL POINTS OF PROGRESS - United States: Maine has become the fourth state to abolish civil asset forfeiture, ending what rights groups call a "civil liberties nightmare."** Originally meant to combat drug trafficking, civil asset forfeiture allows law enforcement to seize private property believed to be connected to a crime without necessarily charging the owner.

Broughton has been asked to nominate current exceptional 9-11 graders to attend the *National Youth Leadership Forum [NYLF]: Medicine*, an Envision by WorldStrides program. The students nominated will have the opportunity to select any one of the nine-day programs offered next summer in Atlanta, Berkeley, Boston, Houston, Los Angeles, New York City, Raleigh-Durham, St. Louis, or Washington, D.C. During the program, students will further develop their critical thinking skills while practicing medical techniques during a realistic simulation titled *When Care is Hours Away*. Students will take part in small group seminars hosted by some of the most prestigious and technologically advanced medical institutions and schools, including the Cedars-Sinai Simulation Center in Los Angeles, The Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine in Baltimore, Harvard Medical School in Boston, and many more. By attending *NYLF Medicine*, qualifying students may also receive college credit through George Mason University. - The next opportunity for tux or drape portraits will be on September 24th during the school day. All students who did not attend a summer portrait session may sign up for a session using [this link](#). Appointment times will be available from 7:45am – 2:00pm.
