**GLOBAL POINTS OF PROGRESS - North and South Korea: North and South Korea have restored hotlines more than a year after Pyongyang cut communication.** Inter-Korean relations soured in June 2020 after a failed summit. To protest activists' anti-regime propaganda coming over the border, North Korea stopped responding to routine calls and blew up an inter-Korean border office. The stalemate softened in April, when leaders of each country began exchanging letters, and on July 27, the North and South restored phone communications. Daily calls have since resumed.
