GLOBAL POINTS OF PROGRESS - More of Chile's "stolen babies" are finding their biological families. Tens of thousands of babies were adopted illegally during the 1970s and 1980s under the dictatorship of Augusto Pinochet. Tirth mothers were often told that their children were stillborn or were threatened into silence by government, church, and health care professionals who then facilitated foreign adoptions, in many cases to lower the national poverty rate.

Seniors interested in being considered for Broughton's nomination for the Levine Scholars Program at UNC-Charlotte: Scholars will receive full tuition, room, board, books and mandatory fees for eight semesters of undergraduate study. Scholars will also have access to funding for four summer experiences, up to an \$8,000 service grant and a professional development fund. The combined value of the scholarship over four years is \$105,000 for North Carolina residents. Completed forms must be returned to Mr. Rudder no later than Friday, September 15.

Seniors interested in the Parks Scholarship Program at NCSU: North Carolina State University's Park Scholarship is a four-year award valued at \$120,000 including the full cost of education, and funding for a personal computer, educational trips, retreats, seminars, and grant opportunities. The Park Scholarship application is currently online at www.park.ncsu.edu and no longer requires an endorsement from Broughton. To be eligible for the Park Scholarship Program, candidates must be a United States citizen applying for fall, first-year admission into a baccalaureate program at NC State. Deadline for applications is November 1, 2023.
