GLOBAL POINTS OF PROGRESS - Netherlands: The Netherlands is returning nearly 500 artifacts taken from Indonesia and Sri Lanka during colonial times. The country's first-ever repatriation of objects followed a 2020 Dutch advisory committee recommendation that objects acquired through colonial conquest be returned.
