

The district will pay the PSAT/NMSQT exam fee for current 11th grade students who have a GPA at or higher than 4.367. Eleventh grade students with a GPA below 4.367 who wish to take the exam (or any other students interested in taking the exam) will pay the \$18 exam fee. <u>Register here:</u> and submit payments through the <u>OSP Portal</u>.
