GLOBAL POINTS OF PROGRESS - Paraguay: The resurgence of yerba mate herbal tea is helping to bring economic independence to small-scale farmers in Paraguay. For centuries, the tough green yerba mate leaves and herbal infusions brewed from them have been a major part of the country's culture and economy. But when Europeans arrived in the 16th century, the industry became dominated by violent exploitation. General Manager Pedro Vega says the democratically run group, the Onoiru Association of Agroecological Agriculture is "looking to create a fairer model of society using our natural resources, so that our young people can stay in their communities and have decent living and work conditions.
