**GLOBAL POINTS OF PROGRESS - United States: A potential remedy to the problem of some “forever chemicals” lies in two naturally occurring soil bacteria.** Scientists at the University of California, Riverside found that the bacteria are able to cleave the strong carbon-chlorine bonds of a subgroup of per- and poly-fluoroalkyl substances, or PFAS, which then leads to further breakdown of the chemicals.
