GLOBAL POINTS OF PROGRESS - Cameroon: The United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization and Cameroon's Ministry of Livestock, Fisheries and Animal Industries are helping people rebuild their lives through aquaculture. Many Cameroonians have been displaced by climate change, poverty, and insurrectionist violence in the country's Far North Region. Fishing is popular on Cameroon's coastline, but officials saw an untapped potential for inland aquaculture to provide livelihoods and help stem food insecurity. Through aquaculture, participants are able to farm and sell fish even when they move away from the coast.
