**GLOBAL POINTS OF PROGRESS - World: Seventy years of data show seabird conservation efforts have been effective.** Researchers documented 851 separate conservation events targeting 138 seabird species spanning 551 locations. Almost all events lured the birds to new locations using social attraction : decoys, bird sounds, mirrors, and other devices.


