

GLOBAL POINTS OF PROGRESS - United States: Scientists are closer to extracting electricity from air. Expanding previous research on humidity and energy, engineers found that nanopores are key to pulling electricity from atmospheric moisture. As water molecules pass through a harvesting material with tiny holes, the charge imbalance between both sides of the material is similar to what is found in a cloud, and what enables the production of electricity.


