Scholarship Opportunity for William Peace University:

Rising Juniors and Seniors are invited to participate in a summer program which will be held at William Peace University (June 17 - June 21). Participants are eligible to earn an annual \$18,000 scholarship for William Peace University. There is an application process for this program. JUNIORS: Twenty-four rising seniors will be selected for the NC Community Development Initiative's YOUTH LEADERSHIP PROGRAM. Participants will receive a \$750 stipend for the three-week program that includes two overnight stays in the RTP area, all expenses paid. The Program also includes a team project due at the conclusion of the program. Applications must be submitted by April 8, 2019. JUNIORS: TAR HEEL BOYS' STATE. Boys' State is an intense workshop concentrating on North Carolina state government and politics. Only males who have successfully completed their junior year of high school are considered eligible to participate. The program is held June 16-22 on the campus of Catawba College, Salisbury, NC. Boys' State citizens organize a state government by nominating and electing candidates for offices in city, county and state governments. JUNIORS/SENIORS: AMERICAN LEGION STUDENT TROOPER PROGRAM. The Student Trooper Program will be conducted at the North Carolina Highway Patrol Training Center June 16-21. Applicants must be sponsored by an American Legion Post [Broughton's Post is 116] and applicants must have completed their junior and/or senior year of high school. All students will be housed and meals served at the Academy cafeteria. Students are expected to remain at the Center at all times except for scheduled training away from the Academy. Towels and bed linens will be provided by the Academy. Each student will be issued two T-shirts, visor cap, PT shirt and shorts, and portfolio with program emblem. Tuition fee and total cost of the week's program is \$200, and is the responsibility of the sponsoring Post. Application Deadline: June 1, 2019, or until full.
