

2020 Summer School Update

There will be two types of Summer School:

- 1) First-time Credit - Online Option (July 7th - August 17th)**
- 2) Academic Recovery (June 16th - August 5th)**

First-time Credit - Online Option

Enloe HS will not be hosting a face-to-face summer school this summer due to current restrictions in place for hosting an on-site summer session.

We would like to offer students that will be attending Enloe HS for the 20-21 school year an opportunity to request to take an online summer course through North Carolina Virtual Public School (NCVPS). **Rising 10th -12th grade students are eligible to submit a request.** Courses that will be available for students to request are:

NC Math 2 Honors

NC Math 3 Honors

Precalculus Honors

Chemistry Honors (not available for rising 9th grade students)

Students are asked to complete the [NCVPS interest form](#) so Enloe HS can determine if the student is eligible for a summer online course. Students will only be allowed to request to take ONE online course through NCVPS. The student will be notified by email of the decision for their request and further instructions if approved.

There is no cost to the family to take the online course. The online course begins **July 7th and runs through August 17th**. Students that are approved to take an NCVPS course will need to login each day to work on the course (M-F) for the duration of the session. Final grades from the summer course will be posted to the Enloe transcript and included in the overall GPA. Students must have a reliable computer/chromebook to use for the online course.

Academic Recovery Option

Enloe HS is unable to host a face-to-face option for academic recovery this summer due to current restrictions in place.

However, Enloe HS will offer students the opportunity to continue their academic studies for courses that did not receive a passing S1 grade and/or a grade of WC 19 for S2 (quarter 3). Students will be able complete work through Gradpoint to recover credit in a variety of classes and bring their grade up to a 60 for S1 and PC 19 for S2. To support students through this work, Enloe HS will have teachers available to provide help to students in completing their work. If a student is interested in continuing to work during the summer to raise their grades to passing, the student should complete this [academic recovery interest form](#).
