Off-Campus Lunch Privilege Rules

2020-2021

Please note the following stipulations regarding lunch passes:

1. The lunch pass is the property of Enloe High School and may be revoked at any time in cases of inappropriate use or violation of school rules.
2. Excessive tardies and/or absences in the period following a student's lunch period may result in disciplinary action and/or revocation of the off campus lunch permit and/or parking permit.
3. A Junior or Senior who transports a student off campus who does not have off campus lunch privileges will be subject to disciplinary action and/or revocation of the off campus lunch permit and/or parking permit.
4. The lunch pass allows a Junior or Senior to leave campus during his/her regularly scheduled lunch period, provided he/she has the lunch permit in his/her possession at the time.
5. The student and parent are responsible for where the student goes for lunch and his/her transportation to and from campus. The school assumes no liability for any accident or injury incurred in the exercise of using this lunch privilege.
6. Students exercising off campus lunch privileges are subject to the rules of student conduct as applicable to the regular school day as adopted by the Wake County School Board and Enloe High School.
7. Littering on public or private property will result in the revocation of the lunch pass and/or disciplinary action.
8. Students are expected to practice 3Ws at all times, even while off campus. This includes wearing your face covering, keeping 6 feet of social distance, and washing your hands.
