Reading Benchmarks

- 26 letters and sounds Capital and Lowercase - by end of 2nd Quarter (January)
- Print Concepts
- Leveled Reader "C" by the end of the year
- Sight words

Writing Benchmarks

- BOY: Beginning sound of words
- MOY: Beginning and ending sounds of words
- EOY: Beginning, middle, and ending sounds of words
- Narrative, informative, and opinion writing

Math Benchmarks

- Count to 100 by I's and 10's
- Write numbers 0-20
- Fluently add and subtract within 5
- Compose and decompose numbers from II to 19 into ten ones and some further ones
- Identify and describe shapes (circles, triangles, squares, rectangles, trapezoids, hexagons, cones, cylinders, cubes, spheres)
- · Identify shapes as two-dimensional or three-dimensional

Leadership Notebooks

- Each student has their own Leadership Notebook as part of our Leadership Model.
- This follows them from year to year.
- Students track their data and growth in their Leadership Notebook.
- Used in Student-Led Conferences later in the year.

Kindergarten Homework

- Read every night!! Question your child about what they are reading, ask them to retell the story, etc.
- Optional math homework will be sent home in Friday Folders each week.
- We learn two sight words a week in Kindergarten. Sight word practice for the words of the week will also be in Friday folders.
