Logistics

Event Times: Diploma pickup will happen in two stages.

Group 1 will begin arriving at SRMHS at 8:30 AM. The procession will begin at 9:00 AM. **Group 2** will begin arriving at SRMHS at 12:30 PM. The procession will begin at 1:00 PM. Seniors are grouped as follows:

Group 1 (8:30am): Last name A through L

Group 2 (12:30pm): Last name M through Z

Reporting Location: Seniors are instructed to report to the bus parking lot for lineup. You will only be allowed to enter campus from the bus parking lot entrance on Creech road. Please do not try to enter school grounds from any other entrance. You will not be allowed to enter. Members of the SRMHS staff will be present in the bus lot to guide your vehicle to the appropriate staging area.

Vehicle Drivers: Seniors should plan to have one family member serve as their escort for the parade. The escort will navigate the Celebration route while the graduating senior rides in the front passenger seat of their respective vehicle. Number of Vehicles: Each participating senior will only be allowed one vehicle per family.

Vehicle Passengers: If passengers will be present in your vehicle, the passengers should be limited to include only members of the graduating senior's family unit. This means that other SRMHS students are not permitted to ride in the car with you. Only parents, guardians, and/or siblings.

Dress/Attire: Seniors are requested to wear their Cap and Gown for the duration of the celebration. If the participating Senior does not have a Cap and Gown, professional attire should be worn. It is also requested that escorts and family members dress in attire that would be appropriate for a formal graduation ceremony.
