

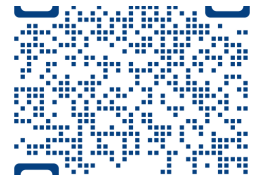

WHAT: 21st Century After Hours-Aiming High is a 28-week after school club/program held during the academic school year. It is the result of a 21st Century Community Learning grant in partnership with the Poe Health Center and Southeast Raleigh Magnet High School, along with three other Wake County high schools. Certified staff is available to assist students in all subject areas.

WHEN: Monday-Thursday, from 2:30 - 5:30 p.m. Occasional Saturday enrichment activities will be provided to supplement missing days due to breaks, holidays, etc. Summer enrichment opportunities will be available.

BELIEF: We believe our students will benefit from the extra support the program provides while our certified staff serve as mentors to offer support, enrichment, tutoring and social activities and of course food.
