Chocolate Chip Cookies

Ingredients

- 1 cup of softened butter
- 1 cup of white sugar
- 1 cup of packed brown sugar
- 2 eggs
- 2 teaspoons of vanilla extract
- 1 teaspoon of baking soda

- 2 teaspoons of hot water

- ½ teaspoon of salt
-3 cups of All-purpose flour

-2 cups of semisweet chocolate chips

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

2. Mix the white sugar, brown sugar, and butter until creamy.

3. Beat in the egg one at a time.

4. Mix in the vanilla extract.

5. Dissolve the baking soda in hot water.

6. Add baking soda to the batter along with salt.

7. Stir in the flour and the chocolate chips.

8. Get out an ungreased pan and get a large spoon.

9. Use the spoon to scoop the batter onto the pan and make sure there is a good amount of space (2 in) between each scoop of batter.

10. Bake for 10 minutes and Enjoy!

Ingredients

- 4 cups of medium strawberries hulled and quartered
- ¼ cup of fresh orange juice
- 2 tablespoons of honey and 2 tablespoons of fresh lemon juice
- 1 cup of blueberries



Directions

1. In a blender blend the strawberries, orange juice, lemon juice, and honey together until its smooth.

2. Pour the mixture into an ice cube tray. Add the blueberries to the top of the mixture once you have put it into the tray. Freeze it for an hour. Insert a lollipop stick or a toothpick into the tray and freeze for another 4-5 hours until firm. Take them out and enjoy this fun treat!

The Amur leopard lives in mid-east Asia, and this leopard became endangered for many reasons such as illegal poaching and loss of habitats. Illegal poaching is when people kill animals illegally for their fur or to sell other items. They are also endangered because humans are cutting down their homes. They only live from 15 to 20 years. Different ways you can start helping is by trying to do a symbolic adoption which means you pay money to help save an animal which is technically yours. You could also try to act and speak up for wild life. The Sumatran elephant is endangered due to deforestation and human-elephant squabbles. This elephant only eats plants which means they are herbivores. The females have smaller tusks than males and are typically shorter in demeanor. The Sumatran elephant is only hunted by lions, tigers, and humans. This implies that if Sumatran elephants go extinct the population of tigers and lions will drop. And then, if that is to occur, the population of prey will increase. It is estimated that 2,400 to 2,800 wild Sumatran elephants remain. We need to do something to preserve our animals!

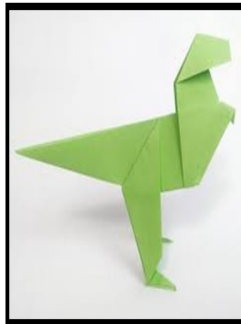

How to Make an Origami Dino

Take a square piece of paper, and fold it diagonally, vertically, and horizontally. Then take the folds, and give it a gentle push, until at the top of it looks like a plus (or an X depending on the way you look at it). Then push it flat on the ground, to make a nice diagonal square (diamond). Take the right side and left side and fold it into the middle crease, as well as the back of the piece of paper, to make a nice kite shape. When you are on the back side, take the top of the kite, and fold it down, then fold it back up. Take the front side and unfold those folds that went to the middle. Look at the bottom of the paper, put your finger through the hole, fold it outwards, and push it down. Turn the paper, and unfold the folds folded into the middle, and do the same thing 1 step ago. Take the top and fold it down, but with only one of the triangles facing you. Turn it sideways and flip it over. Take the left side, and fold it to the middle crease, then un-

fold it. Turn it upside down and take the right side and fold it to the middle crease, then unfold it, and turn the paper back to upside side up. Fold the paper in half (outwards), while slowly pushing the top inwards. Fold the triangle on the top, in half, then unfold so there's a nice crease. Now take the edge of the triangle on top, and fold it to the middle, so the triangle is facing outwards. Unfold it and do the same on the other side of the top triangle. Now, slowly fold it outwards, and upwards. Then turn it sideways, to make it look like a mutated swan. Now fold the top triangle (Future head) inwards, to make a nice dull nose. Then take the triangle under the head (Future hands) and fold it inwards, and downwards. Then take the back long triangle and fold it down (there are 3 triangles so take only 1 and fold it down). Do the same with the other side (Then it'll look like 2 legs and a tail in between). Take one of the legs and fold the bottom of it sideways (the way the tail is pointing), and do the same with the other leg. Then fold it back forwards, but not all the way, and do this to the other leg. Origami dinosaur!
