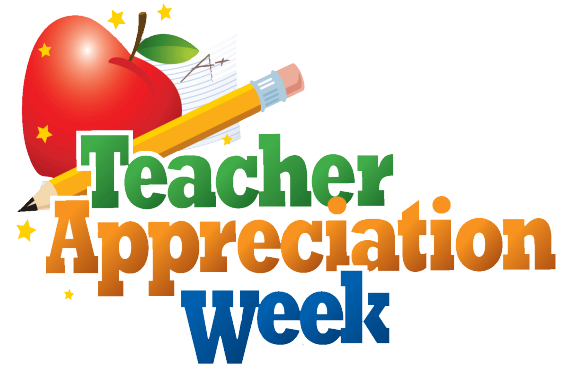


Aviator News May 2020

Governor Cooper recently announced that all public school buildings will remain closed for the rest of the school year.
