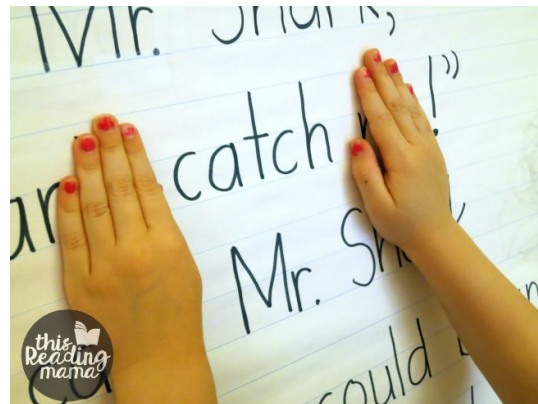

- Letters and sounds

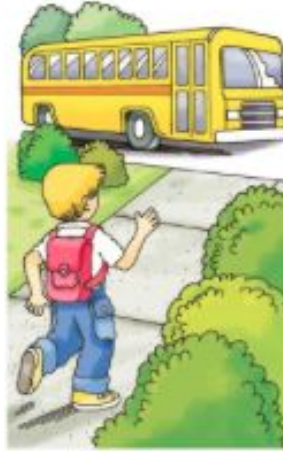


WHAT IS LEVEL RB?

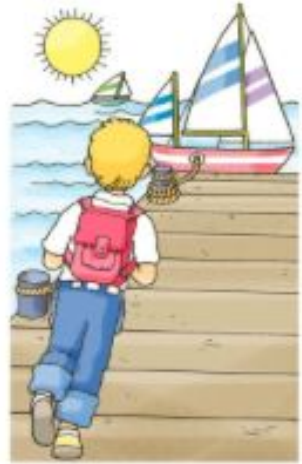

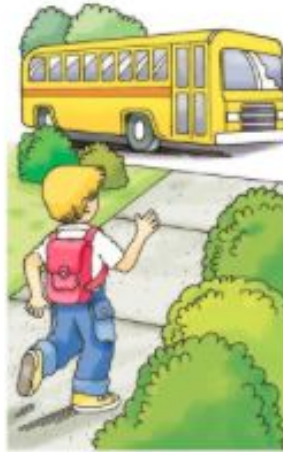
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WHAT IS LEVEL A?

He runs to the bus.

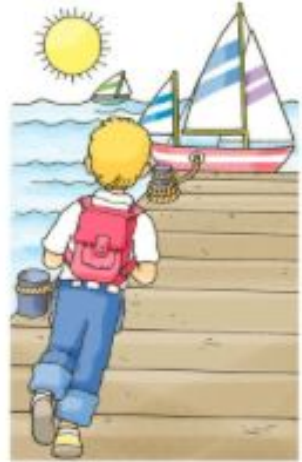
