



LRMS BYODTL POLICIES & PERMISSION FORM

We have revamped our BYOD program with the goal of increasing the learning potential that comes from a device and reducing the distractions. Beginning October 7, 2019, Leesville Road Middle School will begin permitting student-owned digital devices to be used at school. BYOD is gone. **It is now BYODTL – Bring your own device to learn.** Devices will not be used for communication, social media or texting. They are for learning purposes only. We believe harnessing the power of digital tools and resources can be a helpful factor in helping a student find success. Students are *not required to participate* in the BYODTL program; however, students (and their parents) intending to participate in BYODTL must review, initial, and sign the BYODTL contract found on the next page. Students not participating will still be allowed to bring phones to school but will not be allowed to have them out during school hours. *To opt out, simply do not return this form to school.* Students who do not bring devices will *not* miss out on any educational activities or opportunities. School-owned devices will be available as needed.

In order for your student to use his/her personal device at school, you and your student must read over this sheet, complete the back page, and return it to school. Please take note of the following points regarding use of personal devices at school. Students must abide by these policies, or may face suspension of BYODTL privileges or other disciplinary actions, as deemed appropriate by school administrators.

- Students must adhere to the WCPSS Code of Student Conduct and the Digital Device/Internet Acceptable
 Use Policy. Students who did not return a signed Acceptable Use Policy form indicating acceptance will
 not be permitted to take part in the BYOD program.
- The term "device" includes privately owned wireless and portable electronic devices used for Internet access, including smartphones, iPods, tablets/iPads, Chromebooks, netbooks, laptops, and dedicated ereaders (like Nook and Kindle). Note that devices *primarily* designed for video games are not permitted.
- Students may only use devices upon teacher's request. **Devices must be stored in classroom wall pockets if not being used for instruction.** Device accessories (i.e. earbuds, airpods) should be stored out of sight until instructed to use for learning purposes. **Students who do NOT opt into BYOD must keep devices stored in lockers during school hours.**
- Students are only permitted to use the WCPSS-BYOD wireless network, which has filters and protections in place. Use of cellular service (for texting, phone calls, or Internet access) is forbidden.
- Students are prohibited from taking pictures, video, or sound clips of classmates or staff unless part of an instructional teacher-led assignment. Posting any of this media to social networks (such as Instagram or Snapchat) is prohibited.
- Leesville Road Middle School and the Wake County Public School System is not liable for any personal
 device that is stolen or damaged. Students are responsible for the safety and care of their own devices.
 Devices should be locked in lockers or stored in classroom wall pockets. Be sure to activate "Find My
 Device," if available.
- Teachers nor technology staff are permitted to provide technical device-specific troubleshooting for personal devices. Note the only time a staff member is permitted to touch a personal device is to confiscate it for disciplinary reasons.
- LRMS/WCPSS is not liable for the actions of anyone connected to the Internet through the school's wireless system.
- Students are not permitted to touch/use another student's personal device.
