

Family Updates 8-10-2020

Thank you for your patience as we worked to create schedules for both Virtual Academy and Plan B students.

Schedule

All students will follow the same 7-Period day schedule for the first approximately 9 weeks of virtual learning (Math, ELA, Social Studies, Science, Healthful Living, and an Elective). When students on Plan B begin to transition into the building, bell schedules will be adjusted to accommodate health screenings, social distancing requirements, structured transitions, bathroom and handwashing breaks, and the sanitation of classroom materials.

Power School

Step 1. Complete the access request forms.

Hand deliver the completed access request form to the school. Notarized forms can be mailed to your

child's school. Download the notary public form or the photo ID form. Check with your school to make

sure a notarized form is being accepted. You may also download and complete the form and then
