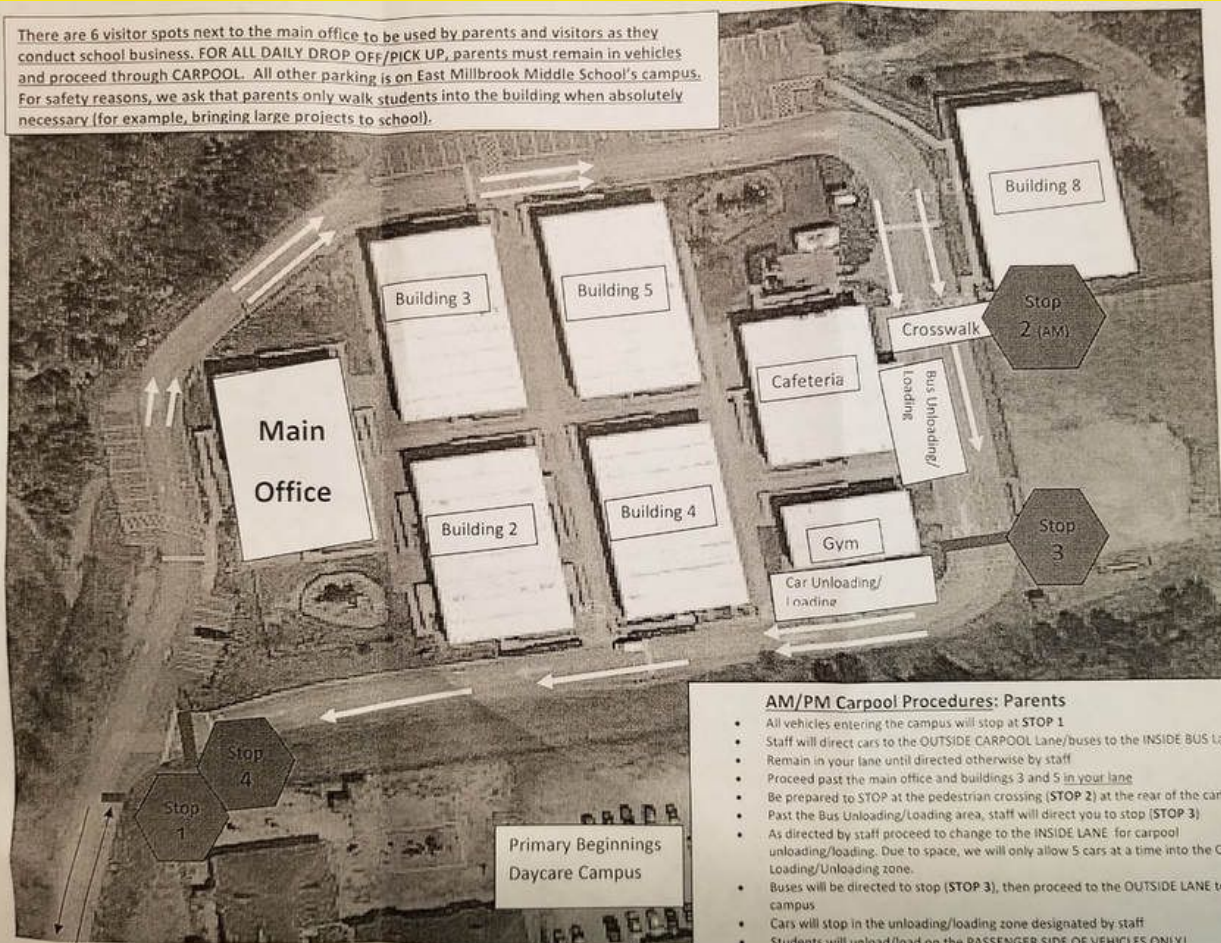

There are 6 visitor spots next to the main office to be used by parents and visitors as they conduct school business. FOR ALL DAILY DROP OFF/PICK UP, parents must remain in vehicles and proceed through CARPOOL. All other parking is on East Millbrook Middle School's campus. For safety reasons, we ask that parents only walk students into the building when absolutely necessary (for example, bringing large projects to school).

#### AM/PM Carpool Procedures: Parents

- All vehicles entering the campus will stop at **STOP 1**
- Staff will direct cars to the **OUTSIDE CARPOOL Lane/buses** to the **INSIDE BUS Lane**
- Remain in your lane until directed otherwise by staff
- Proceed past the main office and buildings 3 and 5 in **your lane**
- Be prepared to **STOP** at the pedestrian crossing (**STOP 2**) at the rear of the campus
- Past the Bus Unloading/Loading area, staff will direct you to stop (**STOP 3**)
- As directed by staff proceed to change to the **INSIDE LANE** for carpool unloading/loading. Due to space, we will only allow 5 cars at a time into the Carpool Loading/Unloading zone.
- Buses will be directed to stop (**STOP 3**), then proceed to the **OUTSIDE LANE** to exit the campus
- Cars will stop in the unloading/loading zone designated by staff
- Students will unload/load on the **PASSENGER SIDE OF VEHICLES ONLY**
- Students will be supervised as they walk on sidewalks into their building
- Cars and buses will depart the campus at **STOP 4** as directed by staff

# Transportation

- Students will be transported to and from campus this year through the following methods: carpool, bus, cab, or daycare van.
- "Walkers" will not be an option next year due to the campus layout.
- Direct bus service will be provided to those students who currently live in the walk zone.

# When are we moving?

Our current building will be demolished following the end of the school year in June. All staff/faculty will move out immediately following the last teacher workday.

Conn will be located in the swing space campus for the 2019-2020 school year.

Conn will move into it's new school on the existing campus location in August 2020.



# What is the modular campus like?

The Spring Forest Swing Space has eight buildings.

The front building will house the administrative office and media center, five buildings have classrooms, and there is a cafeteria and gym.

The classroom buildings all have a hallway down the middle with classrooms on either side and a set of bathrooms.

There are two playgrounds for K-2 / 3-5

There is no interface between East Millbrook Middle School students and the Swing Space students.



# What changes will my child see?

The administrative team, faculty and staff will be the same.

All traditional school events and activities will continue.

The change in the physical campus space will be the biggest difference. Students will need to acclimate to the new campus and layout.

The modular campus/school is more compact allowing for easier, less time-consuming transitions between classes.

There will be more bathrooms for students and teachers.

There are no covered walkways between the buildings.

Visitors must be buzzed into the campus.

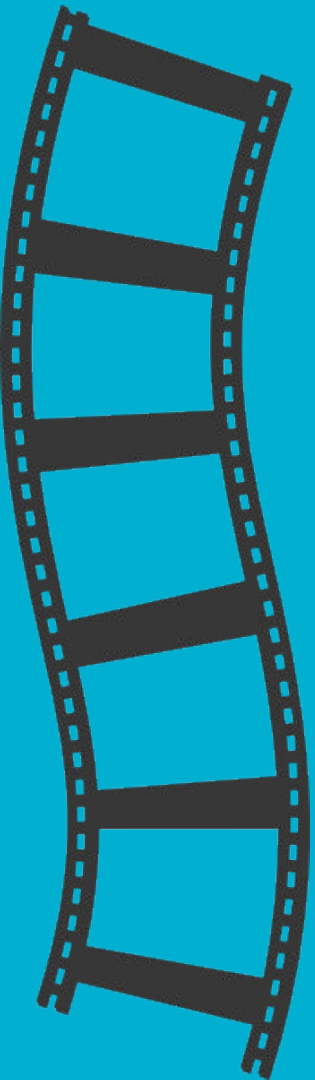

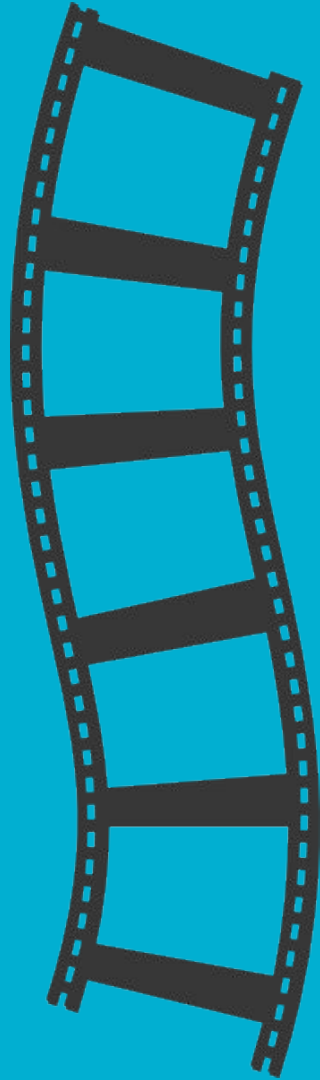
Communications will be sent out via Member Hub, Conn's Twitter and Facebook, weekly updates, pages, along with Friday folders and teacher communication.

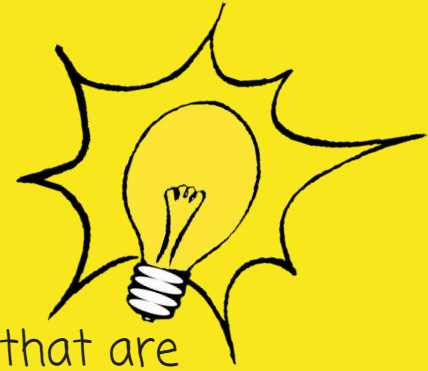








# OUR FUTURE IS BRIGHT!

- Pronounced front entry and the entrance security features that are included in all of our new schools.
