HOW DO I... TAKE MY EOC/CTE TEST?

The EOC/CTE testing schedule for the week of January 11-15, 2021 can be found on the WFHS website or at this <u>link</u>. Please pay particular attention to the notes at the bottom of the schedule.

Students are not permitted to have cell phones/smart watches in the testing rooms.

WFHS will not be providing handheld calculators. There is a Desmos calculator built-in to the testing software. Students should be familiar with this calculator through the work they have done in their math courses. Students may bring their own approved calculator to the testing session. They will be required to clear the memory on their personal calculator prior to the start of the test.

Students may be dismissed from school at the conclusion of the exam period. They will need an Early Release form each day they test. Forms will be available on the WFHS website by Winter Break.
