TEAM OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR

8th GRADE CELEBRATIONS (4 member team min): PTA hosts 8th grade celebrations.

- Holds planning meetings in Jan/Feb about the dance, picnic and graduation ceremony.
- Coordinates with 8th grade AP and teachers about plans for events.
- Secures vendors (food, DJ, other) and supplies (decorating).

Great for 8th grade parents who want to be a part of a special time for their students! Team members are available for the event dates (planning includes email/evening opportunities).

BOOK FAIR (2 member team min): PTA supports the Media Center for the book fair.

- Creates sign up for volunteers to help at the book fair.
- Helps set up the Fri. before the book fair.
- Opens and closes the book fair each day (cash box counting, adding change).

Great for members who could take turns opening and closing the fair during the day.

COPY TEAM (6 member team min): PTA supports staff in making school copies.

- Sets a weekly Tuesday schedule on MemberHub for team members to make copies.
- Members copy and organize copies for teachers when on the schedule (3 shifts per Tues.).

Great for members who can help during the school day and enjoy independent tasks.

<u>DANCES</u> (2 team member min): Twice a year PTA assists with concessions at the school dances.

- Organizes items needed for the dance by using existing spreadsheet.
- Procures necessary items for the dance.
- Creates sign up for volunteers to help sell concessions during the dance.
- Oversees setup, sales and cleanup during the dance (5-8:30pm volunteer shift).

Perfect for working parents/caregivers and is a very limited, twice a year commitment.

<u>FALL/NO FUSS FUNDRAISER</u> (3 member team min): PTA raises money at the beginning of each school year for funding, including furniture and technology upgrades for our students.

- Holds planning meetings in May and Aug to help plan the fundraiser.
- Creates marketing for fundraising (including No-Fuss info such as HT VIC Card info).
- Gathers supplies and merchandise needed for fundraising.
- Distributes merchandise if needed to students.

<u>PANTHER PROVISIONS</u> (2 member team min): PTA partners with Student Services on initiatives to help DDMS students in need of extra assistance.

- Creates sign ups for items needed for school donation drives (2-3 max).
- Organizes items for distribution to families.
- Assists in distribution if needed.

This is a limited time commitment two or three times a year. One team member should be able to come to school once or twice during each donation drive.

<u>REFLECTIONS</u> (2 member team min): PTA supports the NCPTA Reflections Program each fall. The program provides an opportunity for students to use their creative talents to express themselves through their own original artwork in six creative categories to include visual arts, literature, musical composition, photography, film/video production, and dance/choreography.

- Assists staff representative in coordinating and promoting the program.
- Ensures timely and organized submission of entries.
- Secures judges for entries.
- Helps with small student recognition reception.

This team can plan from home using email with limited at-school involvement. Team members should be available for small recognition event. This is a limited time commitment that ends in the fall.

SPIRITWEAR (2 member team min): PTA sells Spiritwear online and at certain events during the year.

- Coordinates with staff and vendor designs and orders Spiritwear.
- Creates sign ups for volunteers to sell Spiritwear at certain events (such as Curriculum Night).
- Oversees table (cash boxes) during events.
- Distributes Spritwear to students from MemberHub purchases.

This team plans mostly in the fall and has limited time commitment.

STAFF APPRECIATION (4 member team min): PTA is dedicated to showing our DDMS staff how much we appreciate them!

- Selects and distributes monthly birthday gifts to staff members.
- Organizes events such as luncheon, breakfast, etc. during the year (3 plus Teach App Week).
- Plans Staff Appreciation Week (held each year in May).
- Creates sign ups for events and supplies on MemberHub.

This team is vital to our school and is not a lot of work with a team approach. Two members should be available during the school day to help with volunteers, set up, etc. for events.

YEARBOOK (2 member team min): PTA assists staff in selling and distributing yearbooks.

- Works as the liaison between Josten's and DDMS staff representative.
- Informs families and students regarding sales and changes in pricing as the school year progresses.
- Coordinates the distribution of yearbooks that have been pre-purchased and selling of the extra yearbooks when they arrive at school.



Please allow 3 business days for code by email. By reserving the Spirit Rock, renter agrees to adhere guidelines below. The following guidelines can also be found in PDF form in the Everyone Hub on MemberHub: https://davisdrivemiddle.memberhub.store/shopping/items/20771)

- * Reservations MUST be made to paint the Rock. Payment should be made to the PTA in the MemberHub store or at Panther Pride Camp.
- * All individuals must supply their own paint.
- * The Spirit Rock may be reserved for one week. A week is defined as beginning on Saturday at noon and ending at noon the following Saturday. We do not reschedule for rain.
- * Payment is due at the time of making the reservation and is 1st come, 1st served. All payments and reservations are non-refundable for any reason (changed your mind, forget to paint, inclement weather, etc). However, if you decide you do not want your date, you can offer it to a friend or sell it to another family. However, PTA will not offer refunds on any reserved dates. PTA reserves right to block dates for school use.
- * ONLY the Rock may be painted. Please make sure the grass is protected before painting. The renter will be held financially responsible for cleaning and/or repair costs associated with violation of this policy. Anyone painting the Rock must leave the area in clean condition. Remove all paint materials and litter from the site and be sure the paint is disposed of properly.
- * The renter painting the rock assumes liability for any individual or member of the group who may be injured and/or incur clothing or other personal property damage. Please be kind to our environment and recycle empty paint cans, etc.
- *Spirit Rock paintings **MUST** be in good taste. Celebrations such as birthdays, holidays, graduation, etc. or congratulations for an accomplishment are examples of themed paintings. DDMS Staff and PTA will regularly monitor the Spirit Rock to ensure that paintings fall within the above-established guidelines. DDMS has the right to remove any painting deemed inappropriate by school administration without notice to those who painted the rock.

Some tips for painting the rock.

- The most popular paint to use is to spray paint. You will probably need 2 cans for a good base coat (more if your base coat is white). Please note that, latex paint and paint that is rolled on will take several hours to dry, as opposed to spray paint, which dries in several minutes.
- Tarps or plastic table cloths weighted down work well to protect the grass.
