Dear Davis Drive Middle School Families and Students:

On behalf of the Davis Drive Middle School staff, we welcome you to the 2019-2020 school year. We hope that you had an enjoyable summer and we look forward to seeing our students on the first day of school – *Monday, August 26*.

This year, our school's annual theme will be centered around 3-D's of focus: "Develop, Drive, and Deliver Excellence @ Davis Drive" Each stakeholder plays an important role in making our school great and this next year, we will continue to focus on taking our school to BIGGER and GREATER heights. As your PROUD and GRATEFUL leader, I am very committed to upholding the integrity and culture in place at our school, providing open communication to all, and serving as a strong instructional leader. My belief is that all students deserve a rewarding, positive, enriched, and well-rounded middle school experience. Thank you in advance for your continued support. Our school hours are from 8:15 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. Students may enter as early as 7:45 a.m. and proceed to their holding areas. When parents are in our building, we do ask that you please be sure to sign into the front office upon arrival.

The Wake County Public School System will not offer early release days this year. Instead, our teacher workdays will serve as time for our teachers to receive professional development, since school will be closed for students. Our teacher workdays for this year are as follows: (Sept. 30, Oct. 9, Oct. 31, Nov. 1, Dec 20, Jan. 1, Jan. 2, Feb. 18, Mar. 9, Apr. 13, May. 1).

Our annual "Panther Pride/Meet The Teacher" event (for rising 7th and 8th graders) is scheduled for Thursday, August 22 from 1:00 p.m.-2:00 p.m. for 7th Grade and 2:00 p.m.-3:00 p.m. for 8th Grade. This will be your opportunity to pick up your child's schedule and meet their teachers. We invite you to drop by to meet your child's teachers and to fellowship with members of the Davis Drive Middle School community. You will have the opportunity to purchase your child's agenda, join the PTA, set up student lunch accounts, and discuss any transportation questions with our transportation contact. Student school supply lists are enclosed with this letter and is posted on our website.

Free/reduced lunch applications will be mailed to all students one week before school starts. These forms must be resubmitted at the beginning of each year even if a student previously received free or reduced price lunch. Any student who received free/reduced lunch last year will continue to receive the same service for the first 15 days of school while the applications are being processed. School meal prices for students are as follows:

Carpool students are to be dropped off between 7:45 and 8:15 and picked up from 3:00 until 3:30 in the carpool lane. Please refrain from using your cell phone while driving through carpool. Please be sure to read over the enclosed carpool procedures for further information.
