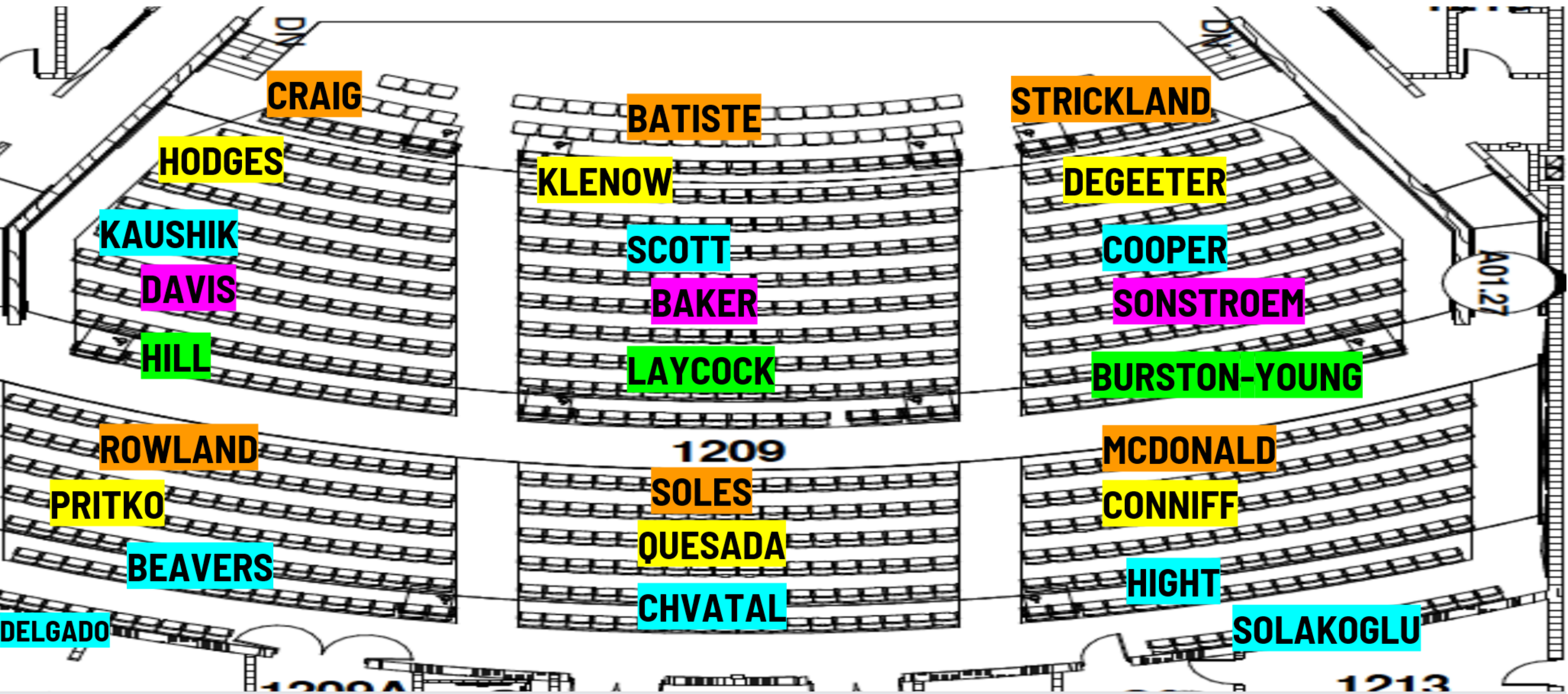

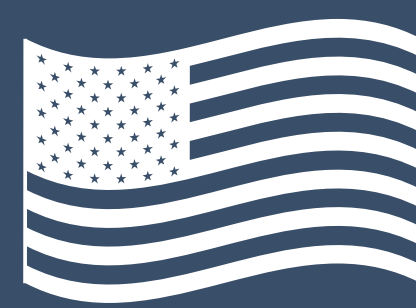

ESL & SPECIAL PROGRAMS



REGISTRATION 2023-2024

English as a Second Language (ESL)

Students who require ESL classes will work with their ESL teacher and school counselor to request the appropriate ESL courses for high school.

Curriculum Assistance (CA)

Students requiring CA (as required by their IEP) will also work with their IEP case manager and counselor to determine whether one or two semesters of CA are required

UNC SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

Always refer to a college/universities' "Admissions" website for specific information for colleges

Ex: Many South Carolina and California colleges require one fine arts credit
(GLHS does not)

COURSES

- GLHS Graduation Requirements cover these, but notes:
4 credits of Math: **UNC System strongly encourages**
future students to take **at least one mathematics**
course unit in the 12th grade

WORLD LANGUAGE

- **2 credits of the same language** other than English
Ex: French I & II, Latin I & II, or Spanish I & II

GPA (GRADE POINT AVERAGE)

- 2.5 cumulative weighted GPA

TEST SCORES

- SAT of 1010 on new (verbal and math) **OR** ACT
composite of 19

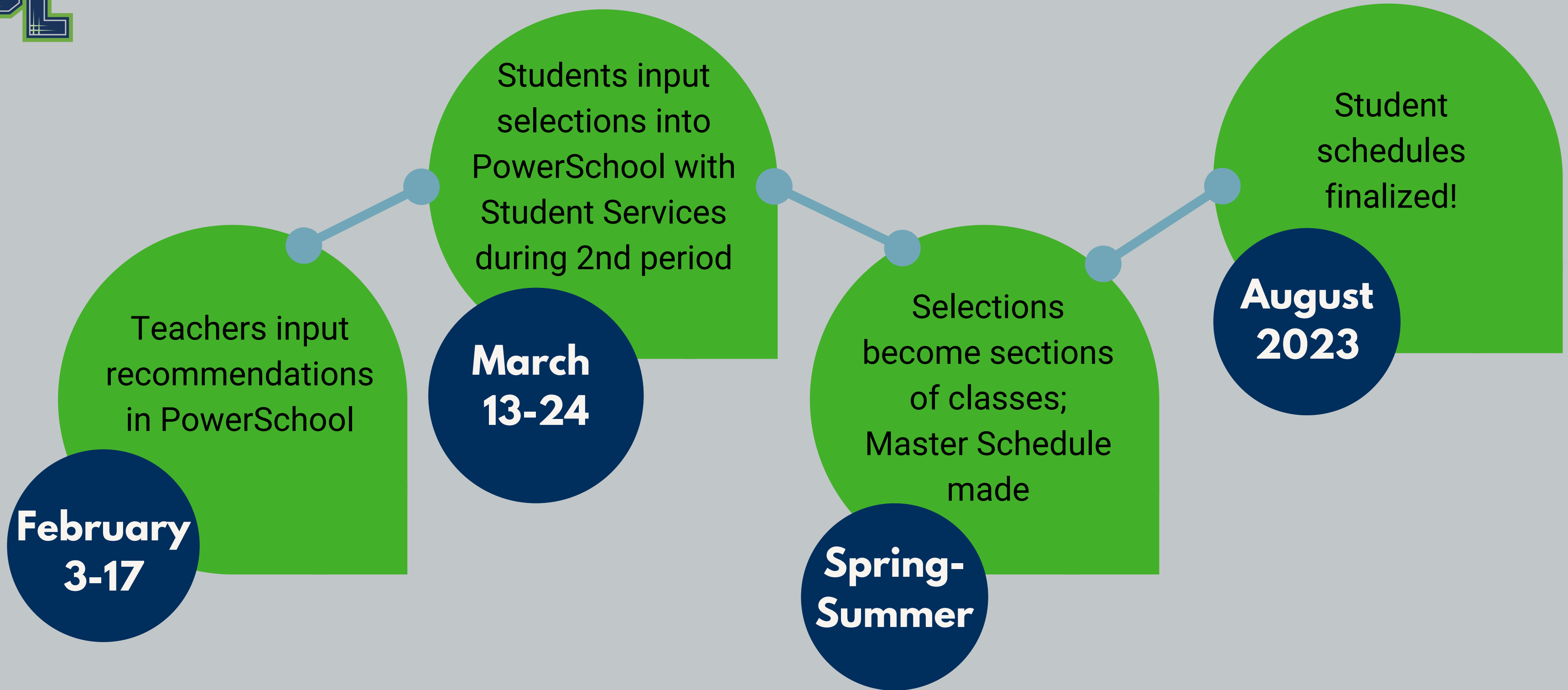

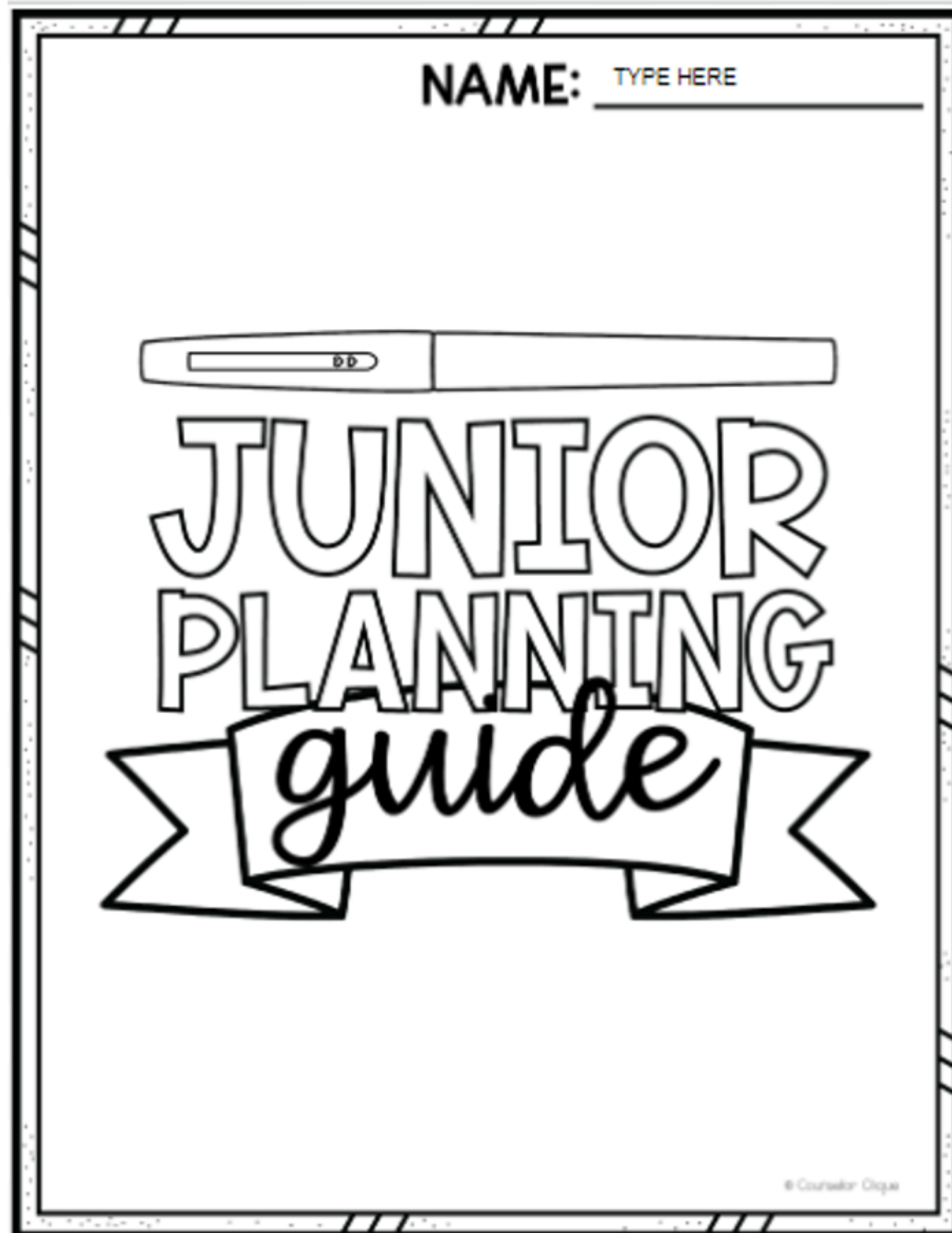
