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ACADEMIC

Academic courses are standard level classes that will provide students with access to meaningful and rigorous work. These classes will often include many different supports to ensure students are successful.

HONORS

Honors courses are a great way for students who wish to challenge themselves with a deeper exploration of topics presented in the academic version of certain classes. These courses are also great preparation for taking AP courses in the future.

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP)

AP courses are the most challenging courses that we offer at Green Level. Due to the potential for students to earn college credit by performing well on the **College Board Advanced** Placement (AP) Exams in May, these courses may have additional demands and workloads than non-AP courses.
