Morehead-Cain Scholarship at UNC Chapel Hill

Criteria

- Leadership
- Character
- Scholarship
- Physical Vigor

Annual stipend that covers full-tuition and expenses as well as a four-year summer enrichment program

GLHS can nominate THREE students or you can self nominate

Morehead-Cain Scholarship at UNC Chapel Hill

- Required Materials: Morehead-Cain Questionnaire (link below) and resume with school email address and phone number
- Morehead-Cain Scholarship
- <u>Morehead-Cain Pre-Nomination Questionnaire</u> (Copies here and in Student Services)

GLHS deadline: Friday, September 10th by 3:00 PM

Students must adhere to Green Level High School deadlines - NOT the deadlines listed on the scholarship websites.

Park Scholarship at NC State University

Criteria

- Scholarship
- Leadership
- Service
- Character

Criteria Descriptions

Four-year scholarship valued at \$100K+ including tuition and fees, room and board, books, supplies, educational trips, retreats, seminars, and personal expenses

- Enrichment grants for research, service, and international projects
- Early course registration
- Guaranteed invitation to join the <u>University Scholars Program</u> for all Park
 Scholarships Finalists

The Park Scholarships program and NC State will not require ACT or SAT scores for consideration for Fall 2022 entry.

Park Scholarship at NC State University

GLHS can nominate <u>TWO</u> students or you can self nominate

- Required materials: Submit a one-page personal statement that addresses how you meet the criteria and resume with school email address and phone number
- Park Scholarships

GLHS deadline: Friday, October 1 by 3:00 PM

Students must adhere to Green Level High School deadlines NOT the deadlines listed on the scholarship websites.

Belk Scholarship - Davidson

Criteria

- Scholarship
- Commitment to local and global communities
- Candidates for the Belk must demonstrate outstanding intellectual ability and success, leadership experience, commitment to service and overall personal vigor.

Full scholarship (room, board, tuition, fees + special study stipends)

- Required Materials: Submit a one-page personal statement that addresses your qualifications for this scholarship and resume with school email address and phone number.
- GLHS can nominate up to **<u>TWO</u>** students

GLHS deadline: Friday, November 12 by 3:00 PM

Students must adhere to Green Level High School deadlines NOT the deadlines listed on the scholarship websites.

Belk Scholarship Program

Bryan Scholarship - Davidson

Criteria

- Exceptional academic record Outstanding leadership abilities Top scholar athlete (capable of DI level in eligible sport)

GLHS can nominate one female and one male

- Amount: \$35,000 annually Required Materials: Submit a one-page personal statement that addresses your qualifications for this scholarship and resume with school email address and phone number.

GLHS deadline: Friday, September 10 by 3:00 PM

Bryan Scholarship Program

Cheatham-White Scholarship

Available at two institutions: North Carolina Central University and North Carolina A&T

- Fully funded four-year scholarship
- Full tuition and fees, housing, meals, textbooks, a laptop, travel, and personal expenses. Each scholarship also provides four summers of fully funded enrichment and networking opportunities that may include international travel and study.

Criteria:

- 1. Minimum weighted GPA of 4.0 or higher
- 2. Minimum SAT score of 1280 or ACT of 28
- 3. Show exceptional qualities of character and leadership
- 4.Be significantly involved in extracurricular activities
- 5.Demonstrate a strong commitment to service
- 6.Be admitted as a freshman in the fall semester into a baccalaureate program at NCAT or NCCU.



Cheatham-White Scholarship

GLHS can nominate **THREE** students or you can self nominate.

- Required materials: Submit a one-page personal statement that addresses how you meet the criteria and resume with school email address and phone number. You must provide unofficial copies of your SAT and/or ACT scores.

GLHS deadline: Friday, October 29th by 3:00 PM

Students must adhere to Green Level High School deadlines NOT the deadlines listed on the scholarship websites.

Levine Scholarship -UNC Charlotte

The Levine Scholarship is offered to 20 enrolling students

- The four-year scholarship includes full tuition, room, board, a grant to implement a service project of the Scholar's own design, and four summers of experiences. The total value of this four-year package is estimated at \$105,000 for in-state students.
- Civic engagement is at the core of the Levine Scholars Program.

GLHS has **NO** limits on nominations.

Levine Scholarship -UNC Charlotte

- You must ask your counselor to nominate you (you must be nominated before you can apply).
- You must provide unofficial copies of your SAT and/or ACT scores to your counselor as part of the nomination process.


