Immunization Requirement

North Carolina law now requires all rising 12th graders to receive a meningococcal vaccine booster before starting 12th grade. The vaccination must be done before the 24–25 school year begins. Parents will need to provide a copy of their child's immunization record showing proof that the meningococcal vaccine has been completed prior to the first day of school. This is a 2–dose immunization; the 1st dose was required in the 7th grade in Wake County schools. UNC System Admissions Update

For students entering in the Fall 2025 or Spring 2026 semesters:

- 1. High School GPA: A minimum weighted GPA of 2.5.
- 2. Standardized Test Scores: Students with a weighted High School GPA greater than or equal to 2.50 and less than 2.80 are required to submit a standardized test score (ACT or SAT).



Prepares graduates for a specific professional career path


Programs take between 6 week to 2 years to complete

Two Year Degree




Wake Tech Community College has <u>University Partnerships</u> with all UNC System Schools to allow students to transfer to a 4-year university as a junior after completing their associate's degree at Wake Tech.

Four Year Degree

- Typically complete in 4 years
- Average annual cost of attendance is ~ \$20,000 (for NC public universities)
- Look at grades, test scores, essays, extracurricular activities, & more
- Typically offer on-campus housing
- Class sizes may vary from 20-300 depending on the school



Things to Consider: Four Year University



NC Residents pay in-state tuition (lower)

NC Residents pay out of state tuition (higher)

Tuition is the same regardless of residency






