#### **BIMAS Universal Screener**

The BIMAS is a universal screener for assessing social, emotional and behavioral health of school age students. Your student received a letter explaining the BIMAS Universal Screener last week during Advisory with the opt out form. If you choose to opt your child out of the BIMAS, the opt out form is due to your student's homeroom teacher tomorrow. The window for teachers to complete the BIMAS is from October 17<sup>th</sup>- 31<sup>st</sup>. If you have any questions or need assistance with submitting the form, please reach out to your student's counselor.

# REMINDER: SOS and Human Trafficking Lessons for students in grades 9th & 12th

PCHS 9<sup>th</sup> grade and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students will be engaged in district mandated lessons on suicide and mental health awareness and human trafficking. To proactively address rising issues pertaining to mental health and human trafficking, Panther Creek High School is offering depression awareness and suicide prevention training as part of the SOS Signs of Suicide® Prevention Program. The program has proven to be successful at increasing help seeking by students concerned about themselves or a friend and is the only school-based suicide prevention program listed by SAMHSA for its National Registry of Evidence-Based Programs and Practices that addresses suicide risk and depression, while reducing suicide attempts. SOS has demonstrated an improvement in students' knowledge and adaptive attitudes about suicide risk and depression. Ninth grade students will engage in the SOS lessons on mental health and human

trafficking, 12<sup>th</sup> grade students will only receive the SOS refresher lesson. These lessons will occur during the school day and are set to begin in October and run through the end of January. Parent letters and opt out forms will be sent home with your student, opt out letters will need to be returned to the school.
