New Process for obtaining DEC forms

All high schools in NC have been given the directive from NCDPI to only issue DEC forms if a student/parent can confirm an appointment with the DMV. The DEC form only lasts for 30 days. We are no longer allowed to provide multiple DEC forms if the 30-day window has passed and the student was unable to obtain their permit/license. Until we are given further direction, please be prepared to show confirmation of your appointment with the DMV within 30 days if you request a DEC form.

REMINDER: New Online Payment System

Panther Creek High School will be using SchoolCash Online as its preferred method of payment for all school fees, including everything from parking to club fees. REMINDER: Class of 2025: ACTION NEEDED NOW

North Carolina law now requires all rising 12th graders to receive a meningococcal vaccine booster before starting 12th grade. **The vaccination must be done before the 2024-25 school year begins.** Parents will need to provide a copy of their child's immunization record showing proof that the meningococcal vaccine has been completed prior to the first day of school. This is a 2-dose immunization; the 1st dose was required in the 7th grade in Wake County schools. **There are over 460 Seniors who have not submitted this documentation.** Please submit these to Christina Erexson at <u>cerexson@wcpss.net</u>.
