New Student Orientation

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New Online Payment System

Panther Creek High School will be using SchoolCash Online as its preferred method of payment for all school fees, including everything from parking to club fees. SchoolCash Online helps parents and community members pay school-related fees safely, quickly, and easily. By using SchoolCash Online, you help increase efficiency and security at our school by making payments directly into our school's bank account. This allows teachers and secretaries to focus on helping students, and not counting cash. In addition, you are immediately informed about school activities! If you have an account from last year there is no need to re-register.

This system puts all the school-related fees for your student online for purchase. PCHS can post their items and activities and assign the relevant fees to your student, so you can then make purchases online using your credit card. This allows you to stay informed about upcoming school activities while keeping track of the school fees that require your attention.

Student Parking Application Window is OPEN!

Seniors and Juniors who wish to purchase a parking pass, may do this now. In order to park on the campus of PCHS, you must have a parking pass. Students risk being towed if they park on campus without a pass or in a nearby apartment lot. Off-Campus Lunch Pass

Off-campus lunch passes for Juniors and Seniors ONLY will be on sale beginning July 31st during office hours. In the summer, office hours are from 8:00 am - 2:00 pm. Please bring proof of payment when submitting your application. Payment will be processed using SchoolCash Online. For more information on SchoolCash Online, see above. Class of 2025: ACTION NEEDED NOW

North Carolina law now requires all rising 12th graders to receive a meningococcal vaccine booster before starting 12th grade. **The vaccination must be done before the 2024-25 school year begins.** Parents will need to provide a copy of their child's immunization record showing proof that the meningococcal vaccine has been completed prior to the first day of school. This is a 2-dose immunization; the 1st dose was required in the 7th grade in Wake County schools. Students' Wake ID account will be deactivated during the first day of school if proof of vaccination is not provided. Student schedules are continuing to be worked on and entered as new students are enrolled. Therefore, they are not complete and could change. Once we communicate to students and

Odds and Ends for the New School Year

Below are some links that might be helpful as you plan for the upcoming school year.

- <u>WCPSS Transportation</u>. Students who have not registered for transportation by this point, need to be aware that a late registration may result in not having transportation on the first day of school. Click <u>HERE</u> to access the registration form on the WCPSS website. You will need your student's PowerSchool ID number. If you have questions about transportation, please contact Ms. Otten (<u>cotten2@wcpss.net</u>).
- <u>School Meals</u>. <u>This link</u> will provide you current school meal prices as well as an avenue to reload money on your student's lunch account.
- **Student Supply Lists.** PCHS does not produce student supply lists by grade level since needs are very different depending on the classes the student may be taken. Individual class needs will be communicated by teachers at the beginning of the school year. Any requested supplies will be very minimal. Students will need to bring a charged Chromebook (not personal computer) to school each day. 9th graders will be receiving new Chromebooks before the start of the school year. Once we have a date for distribution, we will let parents know.
- **Class Syllabi.** Teachers will provide their syllabus for classes to students on the first day of class.
- **Cell Phone Policy.** PCHS will have a cell phone policy this school year. This will be communicated in advance to all students and parents. Please know that cell phone use in class is a major distraction to student engagement. Students will not need a cell phone in class and should not have them visible. Please begin talking about this with your student and we would appreciate your support in trying to curb student usage of cell phones during class time.
