REMINDER: Bus Transportation

Buses are at capacity and many students are riding incorrect routes. Please check your student's bus transportation in PowerSchool in the transportation tab. If you see a "N" that means your student does not have a bus route and you will need to complete a bus rider registration form for the 2024-25 school year found <u>HERE</u>. Once your registration has been processed and your student has been routed, you will see a route number assigned in PowerSchool. You should also receive an email letting you know that your child is able to begin riding that route. Ms. Otten is unable to add students to routes, this is a function of the transportation operations office. She can tell your student what route they ride and provide instructions on how to complete the bus rider registration form. Joint custody forms can be requested by emailing Ms. Otten at <u>cotten2@wcpss.net</u> if you have questions.

REMINDER: New Bus Delay Notification System

Parents of students who ride the bus now can receive up-to-the-minute notifications via text and/or email when their child's bus is delayed. To receive these messages, you will need to make sure you have given permission to receive text and/or email notifications via <u>SchoolMessenger</u>. You can also check for bus delays by clicking on the Live Bus Updates link on your school's transportation page, or by visiting <u>wcpss.net/busupdates</u>. You also can still track your child's bus using the <u>Here Comes the Bus</u> app.

REMINDER: Carpool

Parents who bring their students to school should only drop their students off at arrival in the Panther Creek <u>main entrance</u>. You will notice the main entrance has two lanes for traffic to enter and one lane for traffic to exit. This does get congested in the mornings around 7:05 am, so arriving early is best. Students may be dropped off as early as 6:45 am and can sit in the Commons. No matter how crowded this entrance may get, parents should NEVER use the bus and student lot to drop their students off. There is signage on McCrimmon Parkway that indicates the main entrance for parent drop off. Students should never be dropped/picked up on McCrimmon Parkway or apartment parking lots. Students should not run across McCrimmon Parkway as there is no crosswalk directly across the main entrance. Students should go to the nearest traffic light to safely cross the steet. Please review <u>this link</u> explaining carpool procedures before next week.

REMINDER: PSAT/NMSQT Registration

The PSAT/NMSQT will be administered on Wednesday, October 9th at Panther Creek High School. Students in grades 9-11 are eligible to register to take the exam. However, the PSAT/NMSQT contains items with Algebra I and some Geometry concepts, **so if students have not completed Math I they should not register.**

The PSAT allows 11th grade students the opportunity to potentially qualify for a National Merit Scholarship if they receive a very high score (generally the top 1%). For this reason, WCPSS is offering the test **free of charge to those JUNIORS ONLY who have a GPA of 4.375 or**

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above. 11th graders that meet the requirements for free registration have received an email from Mrs. Bougher with a registration form.

All other 9-11 grade students who wish to register should pay the \$15.30 fee via <u>SchoolCash</u> <u>Online</u>. The deadline for all students to register is September 6th, no exceptions. Please contact the Testing Coordinator, Alexandria Bougher at abougher@wcpss.net with questions.

REMINDER: PCHS Testing Information- Please read!

In an effort to provide communication in a timely manner, we have compiled a list of testing dates for Panther Creek for the 2024-25 school year. We hope that having this information in advance will prevent student absences during required test sessions. All participating students are expected to be on campus for these exams on the dates indicated below.

- **PSAT/NMSQT, October 9th:** The PSAT is available to any 9-11th grade student who wishes to participate. Students will be registered for the exam when they pay the fee through School Cash Online. More information will be provided once registration opens later this month.
- **PreACT, November 6th & 7th:** All sophomores are required to take the PreACT. No registration is required. The exam consists of English, Math, Reading, and Science questions.
- Fall Semester Final Exams, January 13th 17th: Students will complete either a final exam or a project-based assessment. Exams must be administered within this testing window. A more detailed exam schedule will be released closer to the end of the semester.
- **ACT, March 12th:** All juniors are required to take the ACT exam. No registration is required. The exam is administered online and consists of English, Math, Reading, and Science questions.
- **Spring Semester Final Exams, June 9-13th:** Students will complete either a final exam or a project-based assessment. Exams must be administered within this testing window. A more detailed schedule will be released closer to the end of the school year.

*Note: Exam dates are subject to change based on the discretion of the school administration. If there are any changes to the testing program, communication will be delivered via Catamount Messenger, the school website, as well as the school announcements.

REMINDER: School Meal prices

For the 2024-25 school year, full-price breakfast will be \$2.00 and lunch will be \$3.75 at middle and high schools. Every meal should include fruit and/or veggies. Milk is optional with the meal and students can choose to take it or not. Pizza chosen by itself is \$3.00/slice. Once slice of pizza with a fruit/or veggie will be \$3.75. Please remind your student to make appropriate choices so the lunch line can keep moving. Pre-paying your student's lunch account is possible at <u>this link</u>. Learn more about our school meals.

REMINDER: Apply for free and reduced-price school meals now

To receive free or reduced-price meals for the 2024-25 school year, families must submit a meal benefits application online at <u>MySchoolApps.com</u>. Paper copies will be available at your school's office. For families who completed the 2023-24 meal benefits application, the benefit continues for

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their student's first 30 school days of the 2024-25 school year. <u>Check out school menus on</u> <u>Mealviewer</u>.

REMINDER: Student Dress Code

All Panther Creek High School students should adhere to the WCPSS student dress code policy. Appropriate dress is necessary in order to maintain an atmosphere conducive to learning and safety. We will be taking time to review this with your students at the beginning of the school year.

REMINDER: Tardy Policy

REMINDER: Driver Education Update for Fall 2024

Fall 2024 Driver Education classes and registration information has been released. There are three fall sessions that will be offered afterschool in the PCHS media center. Registration will open on Thursday, September 12, 2024 at 11:00 am on a first come, first serve basis. Once the sessions (35 seats each) are full, they will become unavailable to register for online. REMINDER: Clear bag policy reminder

As required by WCPSS, Panther Creek High will require clear bags at all spectator events. This includes athletic events, performing arts events, and other events outside of the school day. REMINDER: Cell Phone Policy at PCHS

Panther Creek High is implementing a cell phone/electronic device policy this school year. Students have been doing a great job acclimating to the electronic device policy. Thank you for encouraging your student to follow the rules and comply with requests to put all electronic devices (cell phones, air buds/headphones, smart watches, etc.) away during classes. REMNDER: Student Parking Application Window is OPEN!
