- Allergies, chronic health conditions, or other special needs

## Attendance

A note (email or handwritten) from a parent/doctor is required to excuse an absence

Notes must be turned in within <u>two</u> <u>days</u> of student returning to school

An absence is <u>excused</u> if it's due to a student's illness/injury, death in the family, medical/dental appointment, religious observance, natural disaster, or court

What is it? Why do we do it?

Staggered entry is a process aimed at helping ease your child's (and your) transition into kindergarten.

## Carpool


- O Carpool tags displayed on your mirror

- Students unload/load only on the passenger side.
- Staff members are not allowed to buckle.
