Autumn

Language Arts

- Students will continue to explore myths by reading "Medusa and Athena." Students will summarize the reading, determine the role of Medusa in the Lightning Thief, determine elements of mythology in the text and provide evidence, determine the theme and explain why myths still matter today. On Friday, students will take their end of unit 2 assessment. Students should continue to stay current in reading the Lightning Thief. There will be a final test on the novel.

Math

- Students will learn how to find the volume of 3 dimensional objects. There will be a Test Friday, October 11, 2019. The test will cover finding the area of polygons, surface area and volume of prism/pyramids. Some classes will start learning about ratios.

Science

- Students will begin the unit on soil formation. Friday the students will have a quiz on the rock cycle and soil formation.

Social Studies
