## Language Arts

• Students will continue to explore myths by reading "Medusa and Athena." Students will summarize the reading, determine the role of Medusa in the Lightning Thief, determine elements of mythology in the text and provide evidence, determine the theme and explain why myths still matter today. Students should continue to stay current in reading the Lightning Thief. There will be a final test on the novel.

#### Math

• Monday students will take the Unit 1 Assessment on Area and surface area. Then students will begin Unit 2 on Ratios. Students will analyze contexts that are often expressed in terms of ratios, such as recipes, mixtures of different paint colors, constant speed (an association of time measurements with distance measurements), and uniform pricing (an association of item amounts with prices).
