Math 7:

This week students worked on inscribed and composite figures and continue to work on finding the area and circumference of the circle. Next week, the students will review for <u>Unit test on Circles for next Thursday</u>, <u>November 14</u>, <u>2019</u>. Students will also take the quarterly benchmark on Monday and Tuesday (11/12-11/13/19). The Math department changed the schedule. The topics will be the Units we have covered so far since school started in August: Scale Drawings, Scale Factor, Proportional Relationships, and Circles. Students need to make sure they are in school to take the test. Test will be online. Data will be shared on Power Schools but not affect their grades, just for informational purposes. _____ Math 7 Plus:

This week students worked on vocabulary for angles and triangles. They also worked on complementary and supplementary angles. Next week, the students will continue working with different angles and take a quarterly benchmark on Monday and Tuesday (11/12-11/13/19). Unit 3 test will be on Friday, November 22, 2019. The topics will be the Units we have covered so far since school started in August: Measuring Circles, Equations, Expressions, and Inequalities. Students need to make sure they are in school to take the test. Test will be online. Data will be shared on Power Schools but not affect their grades, just for informational purposes.

Students will start this week by presenting their end of Unit 3 projects. Students will start Unit 4: The Age of Absolutism and Enlightenment. Unit 4 covers the changes from the ancient world

and the governments they implemented to the creation of the modern society. New ideas about who should process and distribute knowledge and power change. The middle class becomes more engaged in their society after obtaining autonomy and economic success in the age of Colonialism. There is a search for knowledge and understanding fueled by the Scientific Revolution and the Protestant Reformation. This search and feeling of discontent increases and spreads eventually leading the independence movement in several societies. Students should learn what life was like during the Age of Absolutism and how it changed for the average citizen by the 1700s. Please feel free to email me if you have any questions.
