Math 7:

This week students worked Unit 4 Percent of a number and percent of change. Next week, students will work on finding the tip, tax, markup, and commission and calculate the total cost using percent. They will also work on discount, markdowns, and original price. **Unit 4 test on Percent will be on Wednesday, December 16, 2019.**

Math 7 Plus:

This week students completed angles and triangles. Next week, the students will work on volume and surface area using 3D figure. They will also work on percent to help review for the EOG exams. **Unit 3 test on 3D figures on Surface Area and Volume will be next Friday, December 13.**
