Core Teacher Information:

Ms. Niang/ Ms. Hardisty- Language Arts:

In Language Arts the Tigers are continuing their journey through Sudan with the characters in, A Long Walk to Water. By the end of the week they will have read through Chapter 12 of the novel. Unit 2 began on 10/1. The key elements we are focusing on in this unit are theme, context clues, and significance. Students will have many opportunities to practice these skills in class and at home.

Ms. Best/ Mr. Williams- Math:

Math 7:

The students are continuing in their Unit 2 topic of Proportional Reasoning. Students will continue to have assessments each Friday. These assessments are either in the form of a Test or a Quiz. At the end of each lesson, there are practice problems for students to complete. These are expected to be completed for homework each night. Students are learning how to recognize proportional relationships and determine if the relationship is not proportional. We are excited about the growth of our students and encourage you to help us to encourage them to keep pushing!

Math 7 Plus:

Math Plus is continuing their unit on Expressions, Equations, and Inequalities. They will be introduced to inequalities and will begin solving inequality expressions. Students are beginning to combine like terms and solve for the variable. They have homework each night in the lesson book. These students are working hard, but we do encourage you to push them to complete their homework each night!

If you read our last newsletter, then you are up to date! We are continuing in Unit 2: The Age of Exploration and Global Exchange.
