## Ms. Niang/ Ms. Hardisty- Language Arts:

Salva and Nya's journey continues in A Long Walk to Water as students complete the novel this week. They will continue to practice their skills in Gathering Evidence, using Context Clues to determine the meaning of unfamiliar words and phrases, and determining the Theme of a text. The are furthering their skills as they explore the significance of the evidence they gather as well as contemplating the factors that have been necessary for the survival of the two characters in the novel. Unit 2 will end next week with the completion of a Literary Analysis essay that will serve as the End of Unit 2 Assessment.

# Ms. Best/ Mr. Williams- Math:

#### **Math 7:**

The students are continuing in their Unit 2 topic of Proportional Reasoning. Students will continue to have assessments each Friday. These assessments are either in the form of a Test or a Quiz. Please utilize the YouTube practice to assist students with their practice problems each night. Students now know how to graph proportional relationships, complete a proportional table, find the constant of proportionality, and use this knowledge to solve real-world problems.
