Science -- Mr. Hedley: The students are studying about simple machines and will be doing laboratory work next week.

**Social Studies -- Mrs. Warren:** Students will wrap up unit 2 with a test on the Age of Exploration on our new test day of Monday, October 14th. In our upcoming unit next week, we will begin learning about how the age of exploration led to the development of colonies by the leading countries of the Age of Exploration.

**Math -- Mrs. Kelsey:** Math 7: This week we will continue our work on ratios and proportions. We will focus on solving for missing variables using the "butterfly method." As of right now, our Unit 2 test is scheduled for 10/18/19.

Math 7+: This week we will continue to dive deep into solving equations while using the distributive property. Please make sure your child is practicing nightly on thatquiz.org with negative integers across all four operations. It is imperative that they know how to add, subtract, multiply, and divide using negative numbers. As of right now, our unit 2 tests are scheduled for 10/18/19 (expressions and equations) and 10/25/19 (inequalities).

**ELA -- Dr. Wright:** In Dr. Wright's class this week: The class is currently reading the novel: A Long Walk To Water. The students are discussing the survival tactics that the main characters are experiencing, identifying the textual evidence, theme, and making inference of the literary text. The students will focus on the 2-Voice poem and will complete the novel by next week.
