Math 7:

This week students worked on Percent finding the tip, tax, markup, and commission and calculate the total cost using percent. They will also work on discount, markdowns, and original price. Math 7 Plus:

This week students worked on volume and surface area using 3D figure. They will also work on percent to help review for the EOG exams. After the holiday break, students will start Math 8 topics such as Rigid Transformation.
