

◆ New Student Tech Guide ◆

This guide will assist you in familiarizing yourself with the technology you will need to succeed. We'll discuss your school-issued device and how to sign in.

In one of your first days being here, a student or faculty ambassador will lead you to the Media Center. We are located near the front entrance of the school across from the Main Office.

- **Issuing you a Student Chromebook:**

- You will be using a Wake County provided Chromebook for classwork and exams. We will check to see if your paperwork has been completed and if a device is on the way for you.
- We also will provide you with day-use Chromebooks for you to use in class until your device arrives.

- **Logging into Wake ID:**

- While at the Media Center, we will check our system to obtain your Wake ID and your Student ID number. These will be needed to sign in to Issued Chromebooks and On-Campus Computers.
 - **WakeID:** Includes some initials and your last name, will end in a number if your initial/last name combo is taken already.
 - **Student ID:** 7 to 10 digit number to be used for login and lunch.
- At launch when powering on a School-Issued Chromebook, you will be prompted to sign in to Wake ID.
 - Under "Select User Type," select "Student"
 - Your username will be your Wake ID
 - At first, your password will be your Student ID #
 - You will be prompted to change your password under set criteria
- If you have yet to appear in our system and you cannot log in, we will send you on to class without a device and have you check in with us the next day.

- **Logging into a On-Campus Device:**

- If you are using a computer in class, a laptop from your teachers' carts, or printing in the Media Center, you will use a different sign in from your Wake ID.
- At launch when using these devices, you will see a blue screen asking for both a username and password.
 - Your username will be your Student ID #
 - At first, your password will also be your Student ID #
 - You will be prompted to change your password under set criteria
