Details...

- VMCCA students are highly encouraged to participate in HawksServe Learning experiences.
- VMCCA students must complete 40 HawksServe Learning hours prior to graduating.
- VMCCA recommends completing 10 HawkServe Learning hours per year however students can choose when they complete them.
- VMCCA students select the organization they want to serve.
- VMCCA students may complete their service learning in groups, individually, or through student organizations.
- VMCCA students will submit completed HawksServe Learning documentation forms no later than March 31st of their senior year.
- VMCCA students will receive recognition for completion of 40 HawkServe Learning hours.
- All service learning must directly benefit people, animals, etc.
