I know we are all experiencing different emotions and experiences right now. I want you to know that we're thinking of you and we're hoping that all our families and extended families are all doing well.

In a couple of days classroom teachers will be reaching out to you. They are simply calling to check on all of you and see how you're doing and to get a feel of what type of devices you might have at home and your ability to connect to the internet. By now you may know that Wake County will soon pivot from review and practice materials to now instructing current curriculum standards, that is different from the message we sent out last week when we thought that school would reopen soon. Now that the Governor has executed the order that all schools remain closed until at least May 15, we are going to have to shift our focus from practice and supplemental materials to making sure that our students don't lose ground with the current instructional objectives and standards that are outlined in the standard course of study. This means we're going to have to make sure that we have the devices we need and internet to make sure that it's possible.
