Eighth Grade students are required to take English Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies, and Healthful Living. The current Math teacher will initial the recommended math course placement. One period of the day is designated for an elective course. Please refer to the course descriptions on our website <u>www.wcpss.net/heritagems</u> under the tab titled "Students" then choose "Student Services." <u>Some general information:</u>

- Advanced Band is a yearlong elective which requires Intermediate Band from Seventh Grade.
- Spanish I (two semesters) is a continuation of Beginning Spanish I in 7th grade (one semester). Upon successful completion of Spanish I (three semesters) and passing the Spanish I District Exam, students will receive Spanish I High School credit.
- All other eighth grade elective classes are semester courses.
- *Computer Skills & Applications (CSA) is the prerequisite for Advanced CSA. Students who successfully completed Advanced CSA in 7th grade are not permitted to enroll in Advanced CSA again in the 8th grade as it is the same curriculum.
- ******Curriculum Assistance (CA) is a class offered to students with an IEP as their elective period. The Special Education teacher will initial the CA class to meet IEP compliance.
